

Abstract submission instructions

Participants are invited to submit an abstract of an individual paper or a CLOSED PANEL for the
EAM 2014 CONFERENCE.

Instructions for preparing abstracts

Please read these instructions carefully before preparing your abstract.

1. Abstracts of an individual paper or a CLOSED panel must be submitted by using the on-line Abstract Submission Form available at www.eam2014.com. Abstract Submission Form will give you instructions as you proceed with your abstract submission.
2. Figures or images are not acceptable.
3. If you are submitting an INDIVIDUAL PAPER, please, select two options from the list: two categories; OR one category AND an open panel; OR two open panels; OR a peer seminar and a category / an open panel)
4. If you are submitting a CLOSED PANEL, on the page "Content" please supply a brief description of the panel, the titles of the papers that will be presented in the panel, name and affiliation of all the speakers.
5. Maximum length of an abstract of an individual paper or a CLOSED PANEL is 200 words. The Abstract should be written in English, French or German.
6. The title of both an abstract of an individual paper or a closed panel should be concise and descriptive. Do not use any subtitles. Use Times New Roman font (point size 12) to write the text.
7. The author submitting an abstract of an individual paper or the main chair of a closed panel, should appear as the first named author. All the speakers will be expected to present their paper if it is accepted.
8. **Deadline for abstract submission is 30 January 2014.**
9. The organisers reserve the right to accept or refuse an abstract, and to choose a suitable session for the abstract. Notice of acceptance will be e-mailed to the submitting authors by 28 February 2014.
10. As an abstract or a CLOSED PANEL is accepted, the authors must register as a conference delegate and pay the registration fee. Abstracts without paid registration fee will not be published in the Abstract Book.
11. Abstract which have not been prepared according to these instructions will not be published in the Abstract Book.
